# Open Access Initial Principles

- Two principles on open access:
  - all data in the CDI should, in time, become full open access. Open access is the norm for CDI data;
  - embargo periods for original producers are fully supported, on condition that such data become openly accessible when the embargo period expires (“publishing windows”).
- These imply:
  - policy harmonisation
  - common licence scheme

# Keeping the Balance

- Promoting common principles
  - Keep research communities in the driving seat
  - Take into account different approaches re. data access and reuse
  - Respect national differences (legal, ethical, societal)
  - Keep some flexibility for new communities to be integrated

# Ongoing Survey

- Ongoing survey about licensing and policies issues on open access:
  - “We support open access but...”
  - ... we want people to sign our terms and condition document”
  - ...we want to keep track of re-usage and be contacted each time our data is being re-used”
  - ... we don’t want our data to be used for commercial (or military) purposes”
- Heterogeneity of requirements is challenging for infrastructure providers!
- Huge demand for more training on licensing and legal issues

- Part of EUDAT's mission is to disseminate and promote best practice in data management
- Collaboration with DCC to create a version of *DMPonline* following H2020 guidelines
  - Tool for EC funded projects
  - Extension to national projects later (?)
- Promote EUDAT resources!
  - EUDAT as a trusted repository for EC funded projects
  - Earmarked resources for open data pilot



# Summary

- EUDAT strongly supports Open Access policy and offer tools to enable this policy
- EUDAT Open Research Data Repository (B2SHARE) can be used by EC funded projects to release their research data
  - Earmarked resources for Open Data Pilot
- Open Access agenda should be pushed beyond
  - making data “openable” or “FAIR”
  - Facilitating route to Open Access
