Annotate Research Data

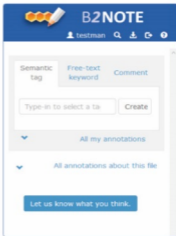
B2NOTE is the new EUDAT service that allows you to **easily and intuitively create annotations on files** hosted within the EUDAT Collaborative Data Infrastructure.

Who is B2NOTE for?

B2NOTE can be used by all the researchers and scientists that need to annotate research data.

Features

- **Three types of annotations are possible:** a **semantic tag** coming from identified ontology repositories (only Bioportal at the moment), a **free-text keyword** that can be used when you do not find a semantic term in particular and a **free-text comment**.
- Annotations are created and stored in a **computer-readable format** (using the W3C Web Annotation model) and therefore are **searchable** (on the contrary of their hand-written counterparts).
- The **search results** can be **visualized** in the UI and refined before being **exported either as JSON-LD for reuse** with your particular analysis workflow/script or software.
- This first release of **B2NOTE** is a **crowdsourcing annotation service** meaning that **all annotations will be publicly available**. To preserve the anonymity of the user, you will have to register and create an annotator pseudonym.
- **Integrated with B2SHARE**



B2NOTE has been released as a pilot service, integrated with the latest version of B2SHARE and it is ready for you to be tested!

Testing will be open until the end of April 2017.
After April the service will go in production.

How to test B2NOTE

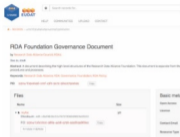
STEP 1: Go to
<http://b2note.bsc.es>

STEP 2: Select a file; Click on the button "Create Annotation" and Register to access the service.

STEP 3: Click on the arrow next to the file you want to annotate to reveal the annotation button.

STEP 4: Click on the button to show the widget. If the widget does not appear, please change the size of your browser window (use Ctrl - or Cmd -). The widget should appear on the bottom right of the browser window. We will fix this issue as soon as possible.

STEP 5: Once tested, do not forget to provide your feedback by clicking on the button "Let us know what you think". A short feedback form will appear where you can:



A. ASSESS THE SERVICE

The 'Assess the Service' form includes a 'Bug report' button and a 'Feature request' button. It has a 'Title (<=1000 char.)' field, a 'Short description (<=1000 char.)' field, and a larger text area for the description.

B. REPORT A BUG

The 'Report a Bug' form includes a 'Bug report' button. It has an 'Affected functionality' dropdown menu, a 'General bug' field, a 'Severity' field with a star rating, and a 'Problem description (<=1000 char.)' field.

C. REQUEST A NEW FEATURE

The 'Request a New Feature' form includes a 'Feature request' button. It has a 'General comment (<=1000 char.)' field and a star rating for 'Overall satisfaction'. Below the star rating, there are five categories: 'User experience', 'Interactions', 'Performance', 'Efficiency', and 'General comment', each with a star rating.
