

All About eduGAIN...



- Global Authentication INfrastructure
- Web site: http://www.eduGAIN.org/
- SAML2-based ("All roads lead to SAML2")
 - Currently mostly web-based services but non-web services are supported too (e.g. via SAML ECP)
- An interfederation service *primarily* for Research & Education
 - Connects existing SAML-based academic identity <u>federations</u>
- Developed and funded by European GÉANT projects
 - But open also to non-European federations

Some Statistics




- April 2011: Official start of eduGAIN
- Now: 19 Federations (now also including UK), 6 joining
- Current Entities: 143 IdPs, 73 SPs
 One IdP can stand for dozens of organisations depending on federation architecture

 Whole (academic) SAML landscape: 43 Federations, 2390 IdPs, 4654 SPs (gathered from metadata) Not all of them need to be interfederated, e.g. many internal SPs








REFEDS EPIPHANY, 2010

The end of year report gives a summary of progress in 2011/12.

Workplan 2013

The approved workplan for 2013 with the relative budget is available. The list of the work items is reported below.

1. REFEDS Coordination and Management.

AIM: To progress REFEDS position as an important player within the access and identity management space internationally.

2. Defining Baseline Assurance within Federations.

AIM: To improve the understanding of the base assurance of federations and to improve the usage of federation infrastructure based on increased assurance understanding and implementation.

3. Engaging with eResearch

AIM: To work on the recommendations put forward by the FIM paper. This work item will identify specific topics and will offer proposals on how they could be addressed by the Identity Federations community, eduGAIN and the related e-Research communities and o offer an international forum where specific e-Research use-cases (i.e., LIGO) can be brought forward and discussed.

4. Understanding and Improving Metadata Flow Across Federations.

AIM: To increase the exchange of metadata across federations and to improve the understanding of interfederation practises and process amongst federation members.

5. Specialist Working Groups.


AIM: To provide infrastructure and support for evolving ideas and areas in the REFEDS community.

This includes the closed Federation Operators Group.



ATTRIBUTE RELEASE

- Code of Conduct to help IdPS have confidence to release attributes to Service Providers.
- Entity Categories: groups defined by federations to give assurance to IdPs that they can release. REFEDS defining 'Research and Scholarship', 'Code of Conduct' (with GEANT) and possible 'Student' category.

• 2012 suggestion: use EXISTING 'social' IdPs and other offerings such as the FEIDE OpenID solution.




